The General Election is a contest between Candidates of Political Parties. Based on the Platforms of the Parties, the Republican Party is currently the one that has a Platform closest to Pro-Life, Liberty, Marriage, Family, and Free Markets that will lead to human flourishing and long-term domestic prosperity. Take this into account on races where no recommendation exists. Also, uncontested races might not be listed due to space issues.

Right of Voter To Vote After Time Poll Closes - Texas Statute Sec. 41.032. VOTING AFTER POLLS CLOSE.

(a) A voter who has not voted before the time for closing the polls is entitled to vote after that time if the voter is inside or waiting to enter the polling place at 7 p.m. <https://statutes.capitol.texas.gov/Docs/EL/htm/EL.41.htm#41.032>
